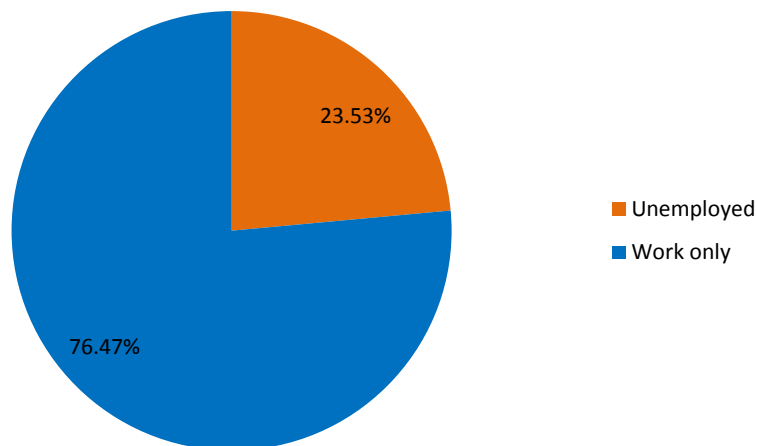

Graduates understand the process of animation, including storyboarding, scriptwriting and sound production in addition to producing the finished images. They can use professional studio techniques and have skills in various areas of animation, such as drawn, model and digital; they will have completed a film for public showing. Graduates also have transferable skills in team-working, creative-thinking, planning, meeting deadlines and managing a project. These are valued by employers and are applicable to many different types of employment.

## Career opportunities

Opportunities in animation include character design and animation, as well as development and pre-and post-production work. The majority of employers are in the television, film and games industries, and relevant experience and personal contacts are helpful. Work may be on a specific contract or freelance basis.
