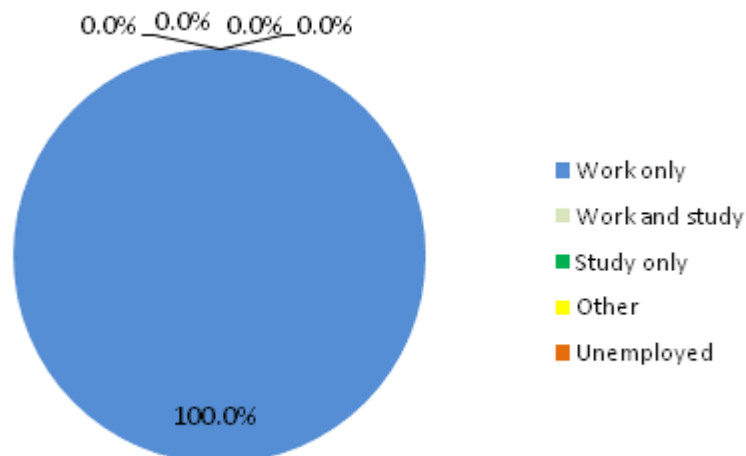


Career destinations

Knowledge and skills

Graduates understand the theory and practice of computing, including the principles of software engineering, and focus on the technical skills and issues linked to the development of computer games. They have related skills in design, animation and narrative. Added to these are knowledge of the quality and management techniques required to successfully complete a project.

Career opportunities

There are opportunities in games development and artificial intelligence programming while the skills and knowledge acquired can also be used in other careers such as web design, software engineering, programming and mobile software development. Games development is a competitive career area and opportunities for work experience and networking are valuable.
