Knowledge and skills

This practical course helps students to gain knowledge and technical skills in electronic engineering. Students learn about elements of microcomputer systems, electronic design, communications technology and data networks. In addition they develop skills in numeracy, IT, communication, decision-making, teamwork, and in problem solving.

Further study/training

The majority of students who successfully complete their HND progress to the second year of a degree course in electronic engineering. The degree course enables students to achieve the professional status of Incorporated Engineer.

Career opportunities

Employment opportunities exist in manufacturing, maintenance, circuit testing, installation, technical sales, or basic design and development. Some students may gain employment with engineering firms offering on the job training and/ or day release training to become an Incorporated Engineer. Students can choose to gain this status through progression to the degree course.
