Knowledge and skills

English graduates develop a wide range of transferable skills which include reading, extraction of information and meaning, analysis and communicating both verbally and in writing. These abilities are valued in many employment situations. The study of Magazine Journalism adds specific skills in writing for magazines and using professional equipment alongside the discipline of writing accurately and meeting deadlines.

Career opportunities

Opportunities exist in a wide range of magazines, periodicals and in-house publications. These are very competitive career areas so it is important to take advantage of opportunities to gain relevant experience and to publish work.

Many types of employment feature high level communication skills including marketing, advertising and public relations.

To become a teacher further training is necessary, the most common route being a one year post graduate teaching qualification, but there are also work based opportunities linked to accredited schools.
