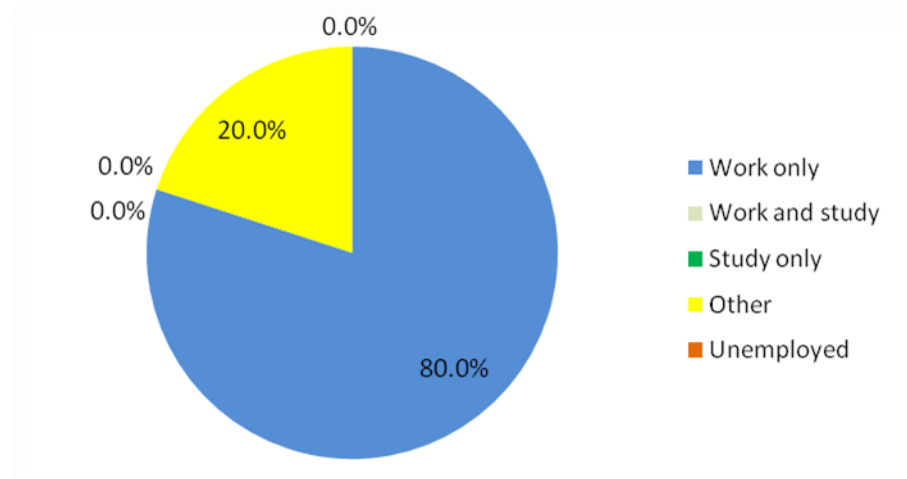

Knowledge and skills

Graduates from this degree will have the skills to operate and maintain highly complex sound recording, production and storage equipment. To be successful in this competitive industry they will also need excellent communication skills, the ability to self-motivate and work well in a team and the capacity to work long and irregular hours.

Career opportunities

This degree places an emphasis on audio engineering and this is reflected in its destinations. In media roles it is common for graduates to accept entry-level positions, for example 'runner', with the aim of moving to higher-level roles such as studio/sound engineer. Graduates can improve their chances of getting work by being active in making contacts in the industry and by gaining relevant experience. This might include volunteering at a hospital radio, working backstage at live student shows, or rigging sound equipment for local bands.
