

Section 10 of the Handbook sets out the University's internal governance arrangements involving academic or management committees reporting respectively to the Academic Board and the Management Board. Powers are separated and specified through the terms of reference of each committee, sovereignty over which is maintained by the Academic Board or the Management Board as appropriate.

The Vice-Chancellor, who chairs both the Academic Board and the Management Board is responsible for overall policy and strategic co-ordination. He is advised by the Deputy Vice-Chancellors in respect of the appropriate configuration of academic and management committees.
