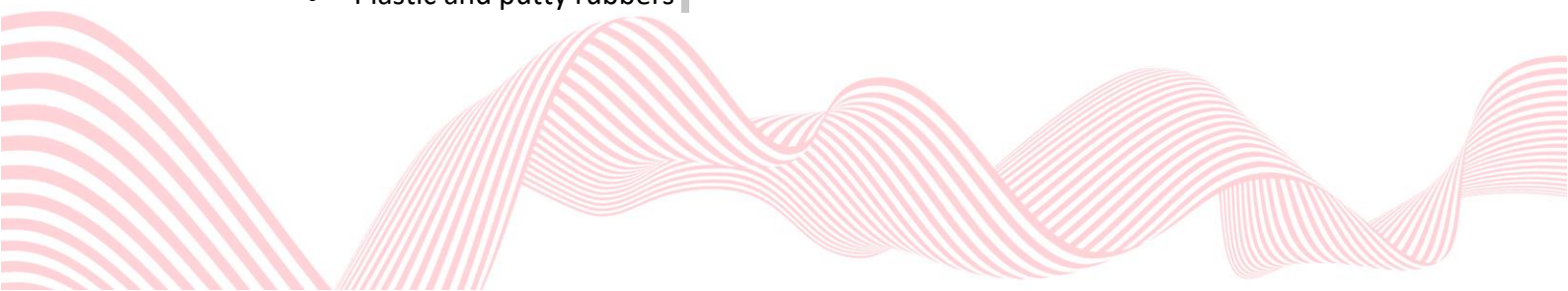
WELCOME

Things we advise you get before the course:

- 1 x A3 or A4 sketchbook
- Selection of soft pencils
- Ball point pens
- 1 x lined notebooks
- Sharpener
- Pritt stick
- Paper scissors
- A portfolio for carrying drawing in - usually A3/A2 size
- Double sided tape
- 30cm metal rule
- A craft knife

Below is a selection of things you may already have at home that will be useful to bring, but if not, you *may* want to invest in them during the year:

- Watercolour box or tubes
- Selection of paint brushes
- Plastic and putty rubbers





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- Cutting mat
