As a brand, supporting sustainable methods of making products with unique art is the future, being aware of the good impact it has not only supporting a small brand but a sustainable brand, allowing the customer to feel comfortable and confident with how the products are being made with eco friendly equipment.




- Upcycling old furniture. -

This mirror used to be an old brown wooden frame, by removing it and recycling the wood to then use a new piece of wood that is solid, allowing the mirror to be strong and stand tall with a space.


A fully handpainted, unique frame, with a pink front, back, and the white edges makes the colours pop, tying the rooms colour palette together with the detailing on the frame using florals and butterflies bringing natural elements inside the room making a living space more relaxing to be in.

The mirror also being a corner piece of the room, it allows reflecton of the space making it feel bigger, reflecting the plants around the room and the colours of the rug, wallpaper and other objects in the space, also reflecting the sunlight during golden hour.

Bringing Plants and Humans Together to help change the way we do things. -


Lockdown madness has made

Inside this table is painted pink, showing a contrast against the white body giving the table depth and dimension of the product.

It also links with the 'Reflection of Solitude' mirror by using the same pink and natural elements.

- Handmade freestanding clothing rail -

Inspired from 1913 Paul Poiret Le Minaret French comedian Cora

Laparcerie as 'Myriem' - Une Petite Salad creating illustrations based on fashion movements relating to the products they make like a clothing rail which has an illustration of a costume design by a famous French fashion designer.

Also keeping to their concepts of bringing humans and mother nature together again by creating

illustrations that have wildlife, florals and unqiue drawings to inspire people to ground themselves back to their roots of being surrounded by nature, art, fashion, all things that inspire them, and that relieves stress to create a sacred environemnt that can heal to find solitude within a living

Using monotone colours on the bed sheets to contrast with the rest of the furniture within the room because not all natual elements are bright and colourful. Parts of nature are organic colours from rocks, clay, sand etc. Looking at

figures, their natural shape, colour, form and going back to biblical times when both men and women would go about their day in the nude with maybe a few leafs covering their private parts, the body figure is also a natural element Une Petite Salad explores within their works.



### Dame Aux Fleurs'

- Handmade sustainable wallpaper -

This is a block repeat print onto sustainable, recycled wallpaper using a printing technique called lino printing. When using this technique it leaves a texture on the surface which can give a vintage look.

Introducing a modern twist onto a traditional classic motif of damask motif textiles, Une Petite Salad draws inspiration from the opulant blue of this 16th century traditional pattern originally used on fabrics.

'Flower Lady' is inspired by a figure who enjoys being surrouned by nature, being one with nature, in their solitude of being naked and free with nothing but the flowers, the trees and the bees.


A unique feature wall combining both modern and vintage features to this bedroom allowing the space to both stand out and blend in at the same time. Making it a real eyecatching piece of work, allowing the other products to also stand out against this feature wall.

Being opposite to the window, this colour of blue can show off all of it's different tones, allowing the room to be darker in the mornings and lighter in the evenings especially during sunset hours.

These flower faces is the face of Une Petite Salad, it is their logo design and was going to show up somewhere in their bedroom design work.


Typically Une Petite Salad enjoys combining flowers, figures and animals with their unique style of how they draw faces, it is their trademark in the art world. Hence why these flowers have faces.

These cushions have been handprinted with the Une Petite Salad's logo, one with a repeat and one single print. The texture of the lino print adds character to this flower face, making sure you know it's been handprinted by the artist themselves.



















#### - Hand Printed Curtains -

Une Petite Salad enjoys combining man-made elements and natural elements to create unique pieces of works that have a

distinctive style. 'Dancing Vases' is inspired from both the

man-made side and the floral elements that can be stored within the object. Vases and plant pots are relatable objects being a home decorative item, and using it as an illustration on material for a product like curtains makes it a stand out piece.

Each of the elements within this design was individually printed with the process of lino printing to create the bigger picture on the fabric, breaking up the images allowed the artist to play with the composition of the design.
