Find a flyer in your goody bag for special open day catering promotions, discounts and deals.



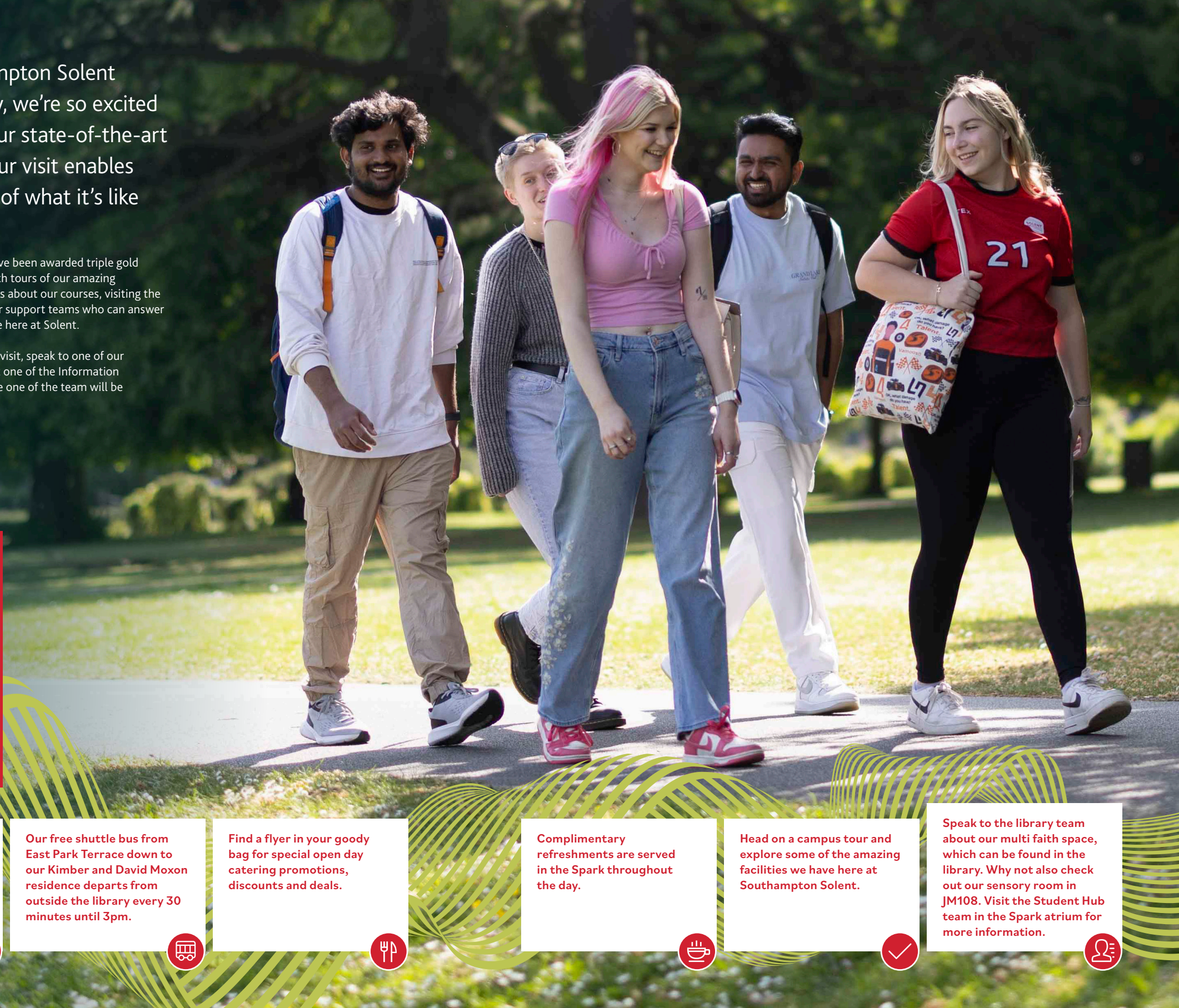
Complimentary refreshments are served in the Spark throughout the day.

City tours

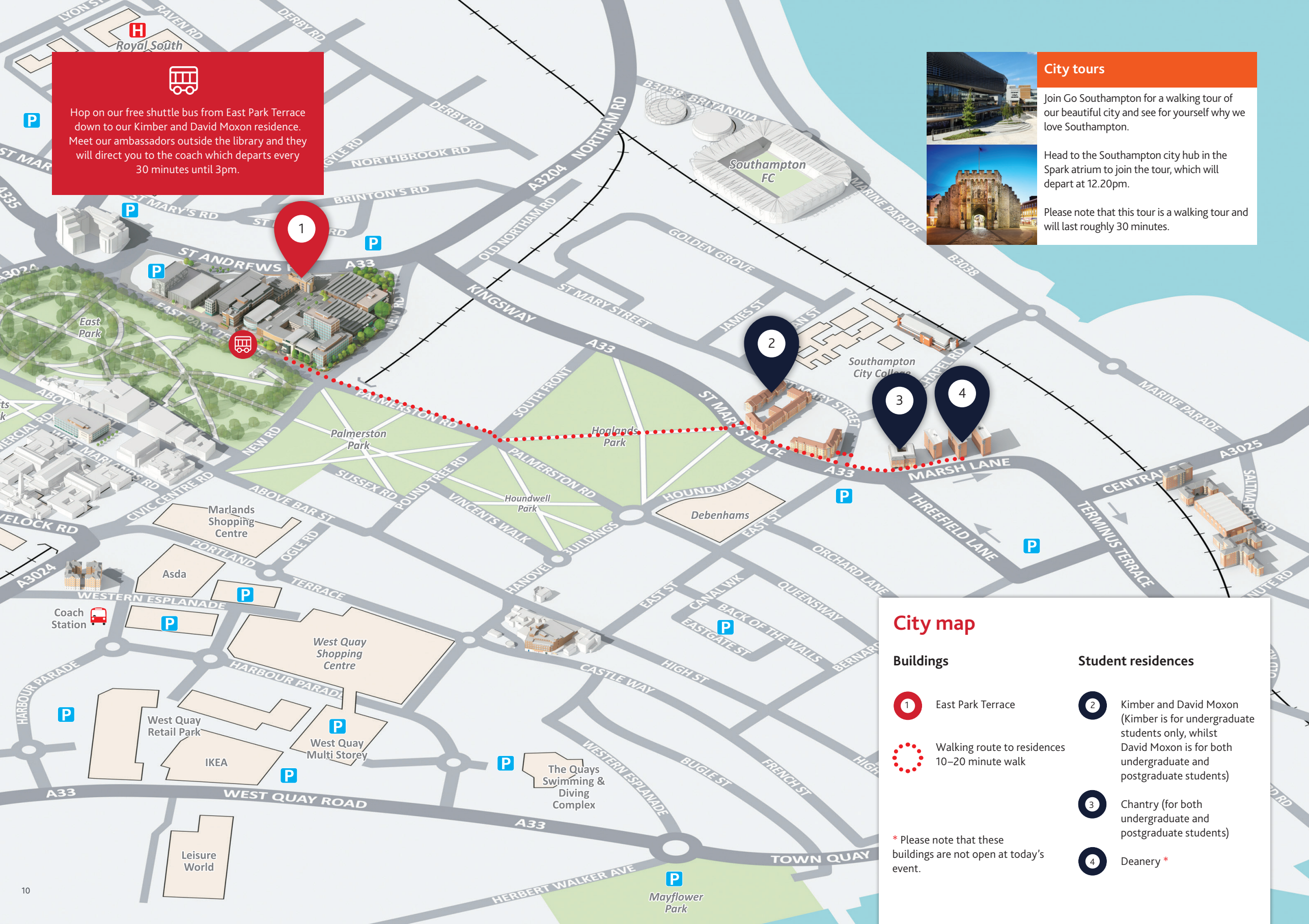


Join Go Southampton for a walking tour of our beautiful city and see for yourself why we love Southampton.

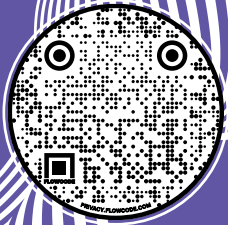

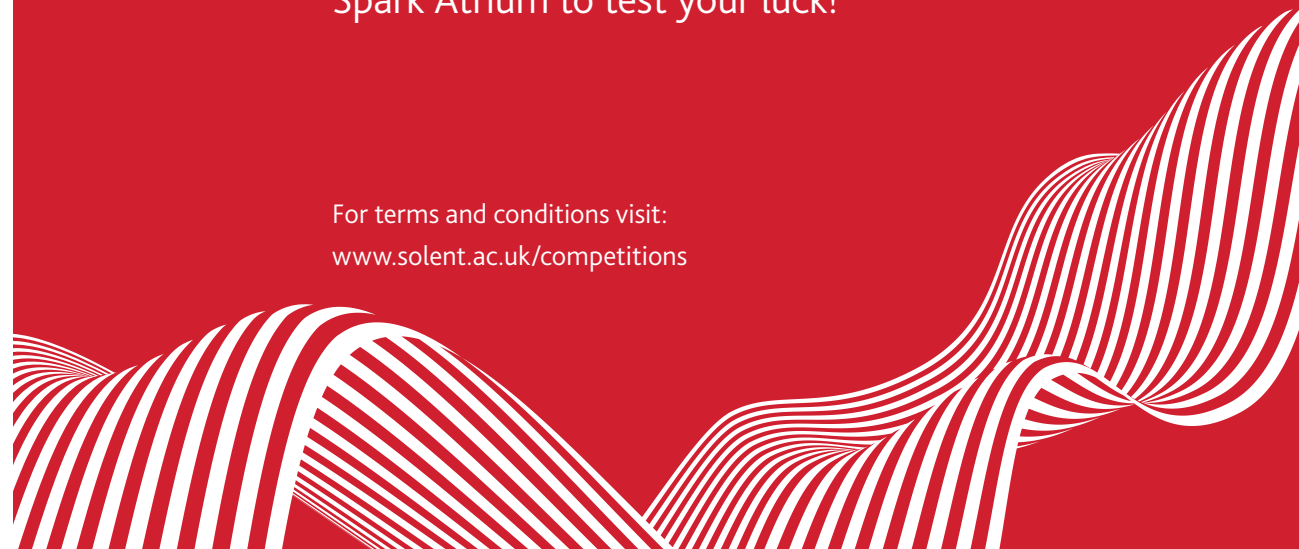
