### Accommodation tours

We have two residences open today from 9.30am – 3.30pm. Head down to our Kimber residence if you wish to take a tour. Afterwards, you can also visit the Chantry residence. The Kimber residence offers ensuite accommodation, and the Chantry residence offers non-ensuite, so we recommend visiting both to compare. 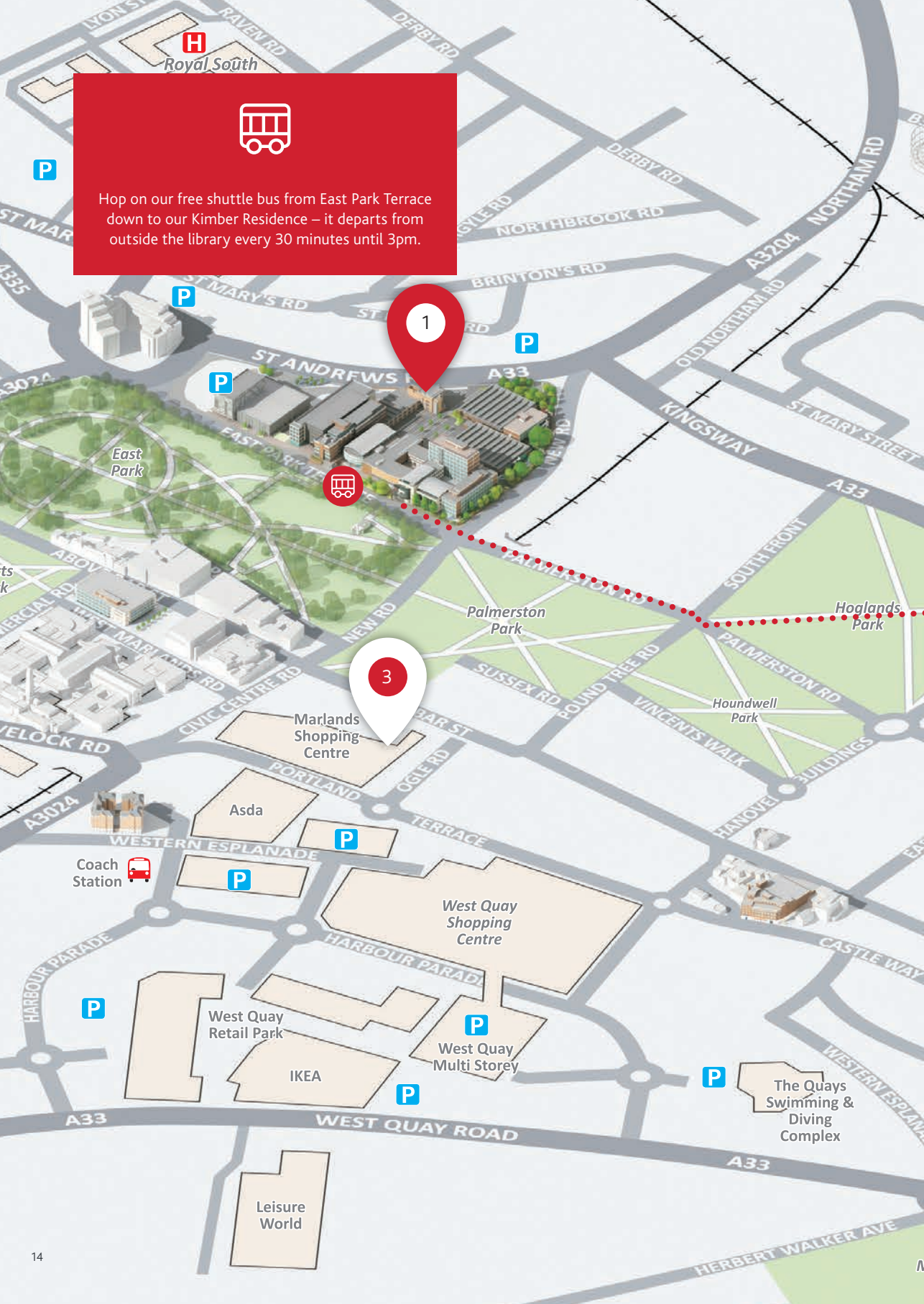


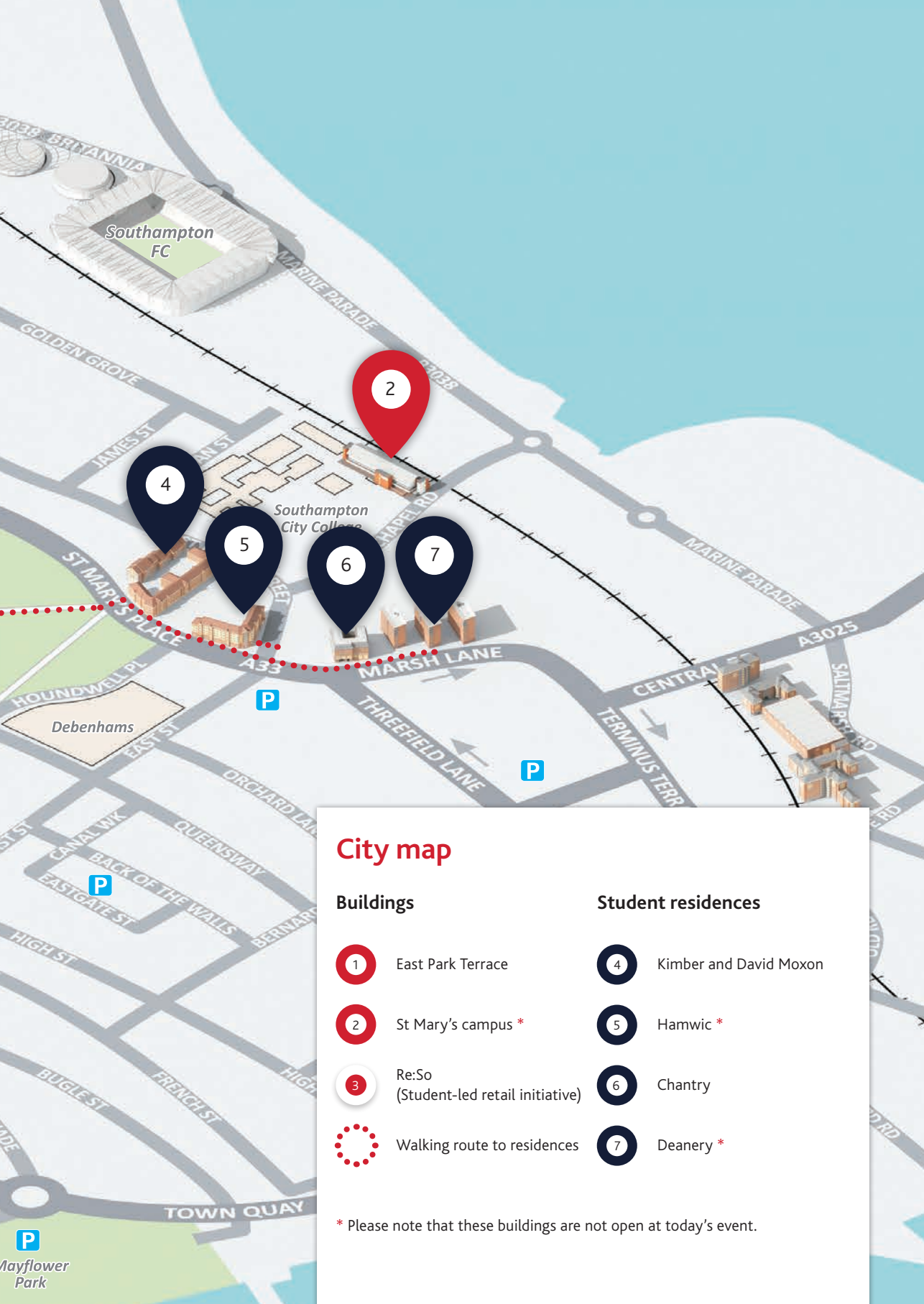

## City map

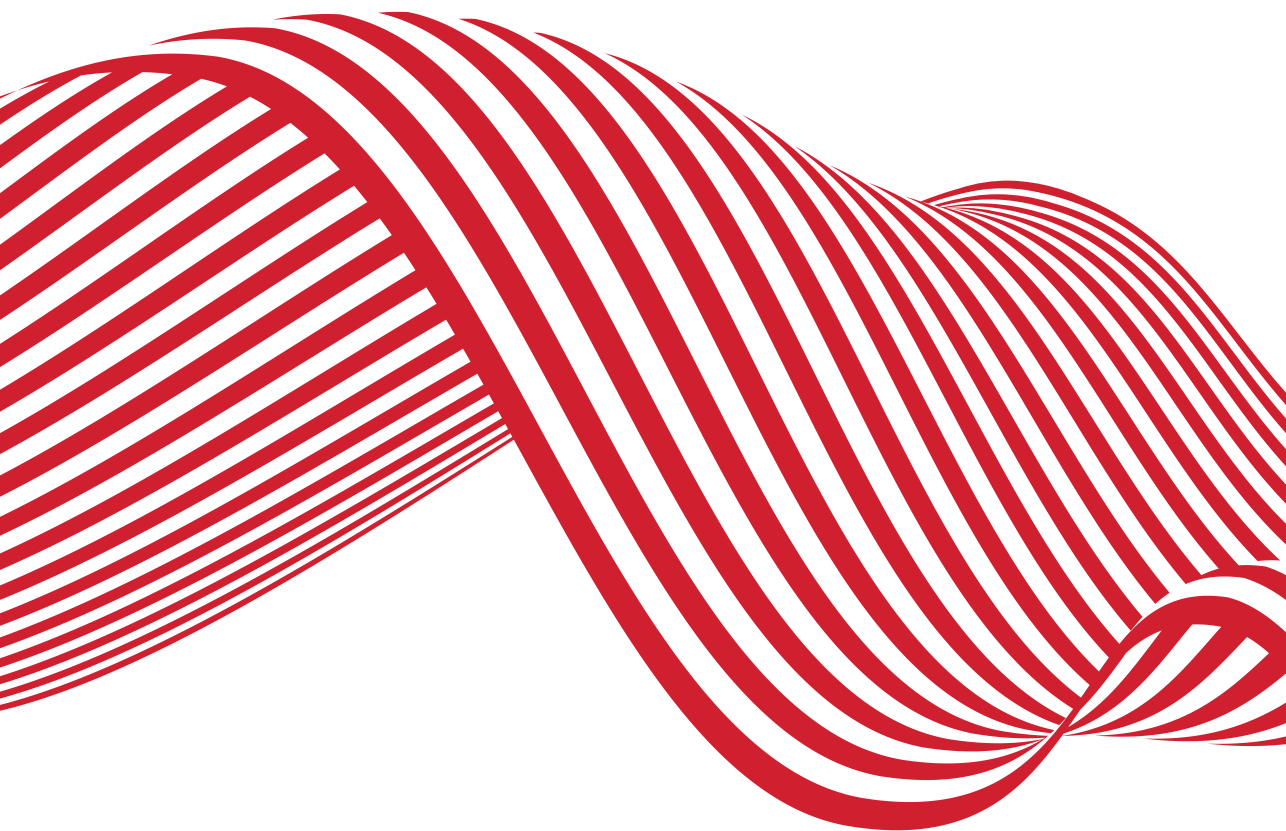
