**During your visit you will be able to attend both a course talk and a course activity. Both sessions are run by our academic course team.**

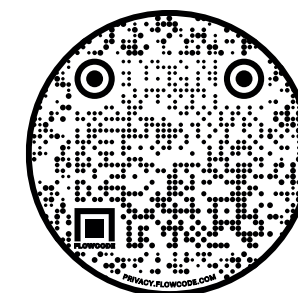

### Accommodation tours

We have two residences open today from 9.30am – 15.30pm. Head down to our Kimber residence if you wish to take a tour. Afterwards, you can also visit the Chantry residence. The Kimber residence offers ensuite accommodation, and the Chantry residence offers non-ensuite, so we recommend visiting both to compare. 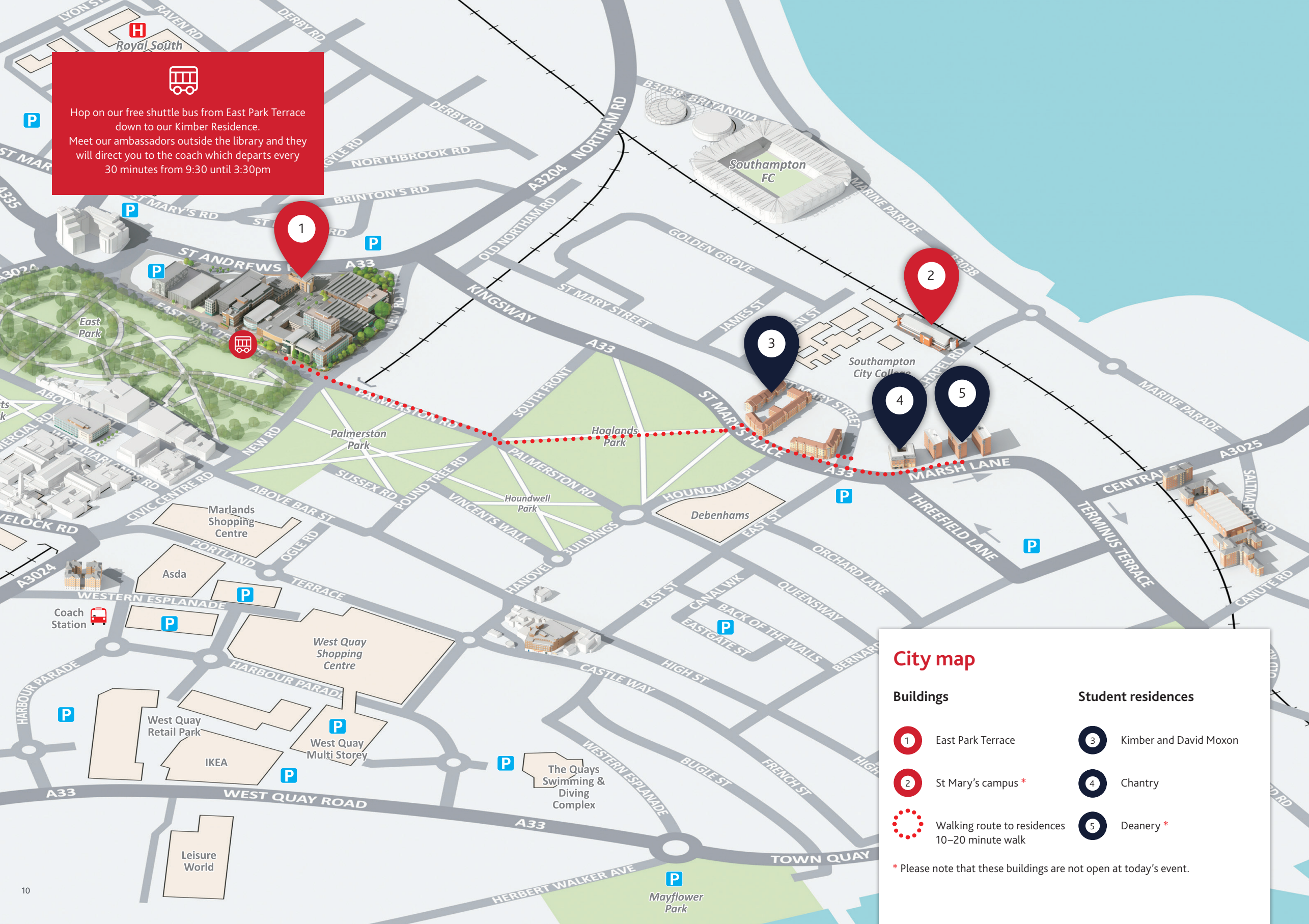
