Find a flyer in your goody bag for special open day catering promotions, discounts and deals.



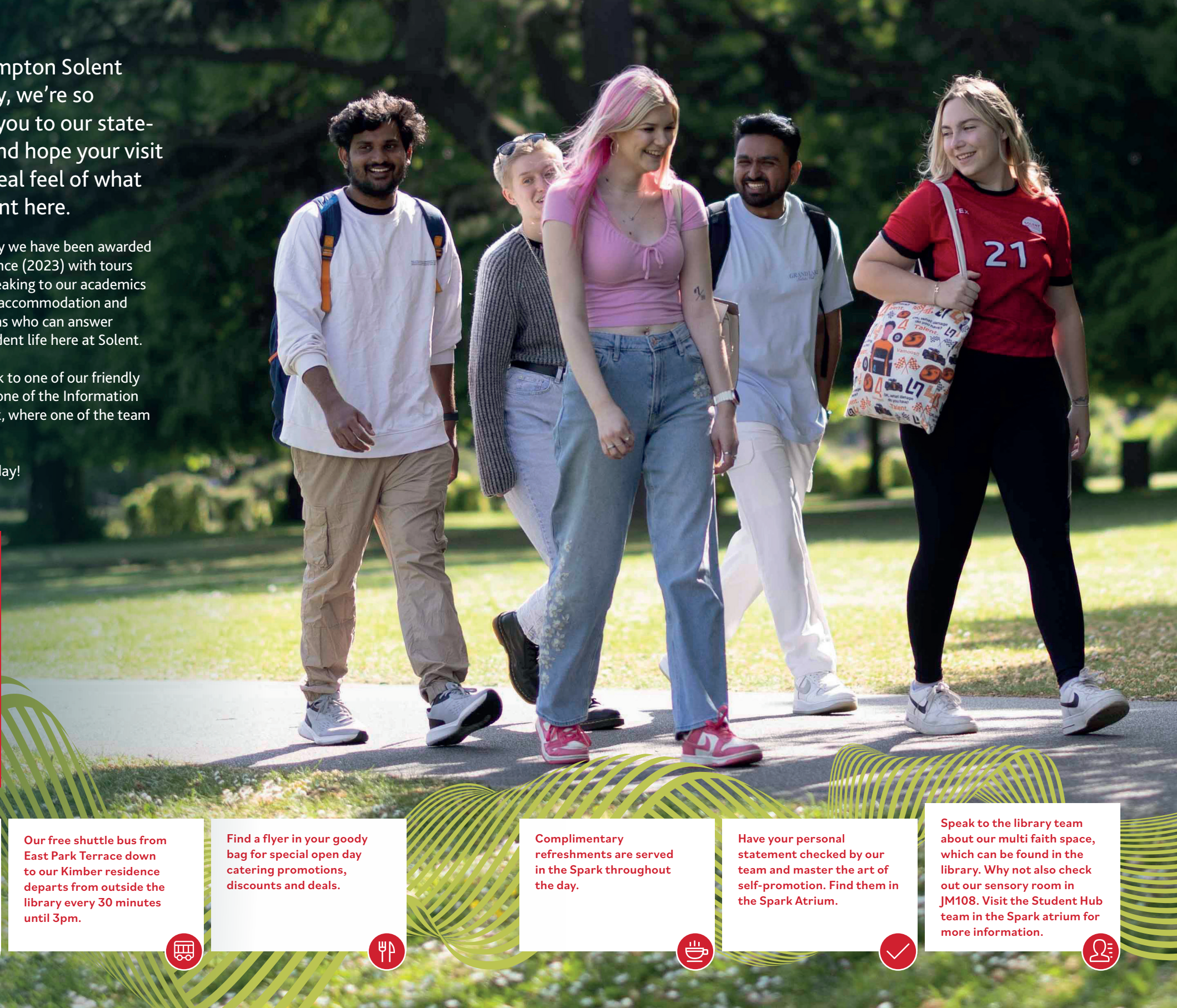
Complimentary refreshments are served in the Spark throughout the day.

During your visit you will be able to attend a course talk for your chosen course of study. Course talks are run by our academic course teams.

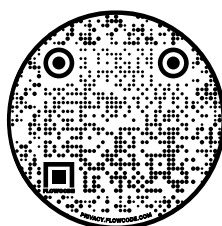
Course talks take place twice, allowing you to choose the one that fits in best with your schedule. Alternatively, if you are undecided on which course to study, why not attend two different talks?

Accommodation tours

We have two residences open today from 9.30am – 3.30pm. Head down to our Kimber residence if you wish to take a tour. Afterwards, you can also visit the Chantry residence. The Kimber residence offers en-suite accommodation, and the Chantry residence offers non-en-suite, so we recommend visiting both to compare. The map on page 10 details the walking route and the locations of our residences, all of which are a 10–20 minute walk from the campus.

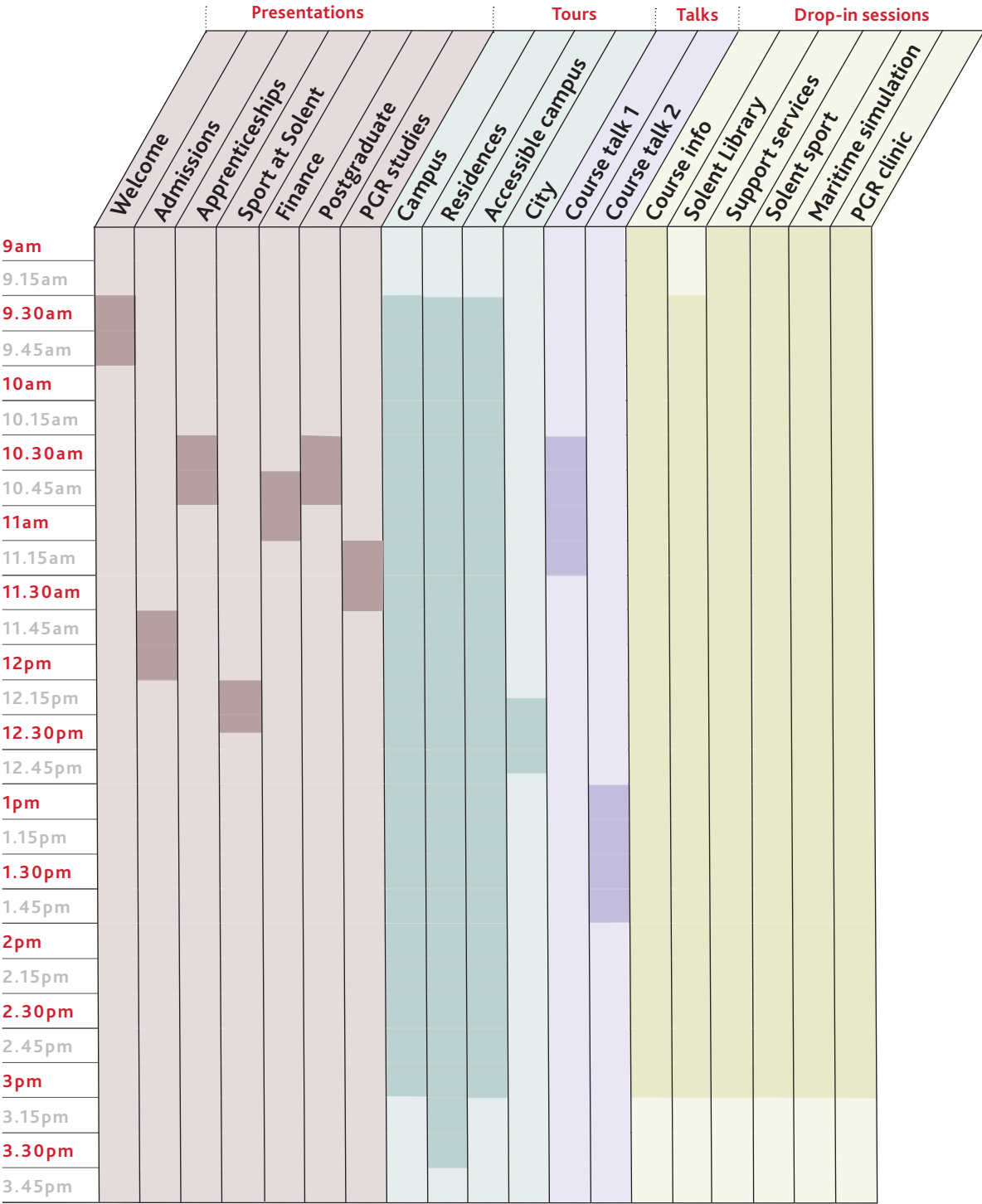

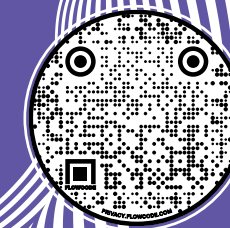
