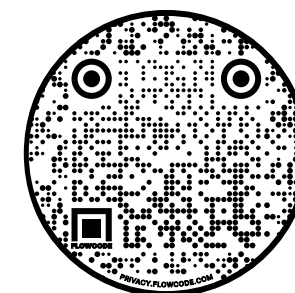
If you are still undecided on which course you'd like to study, why not attend two different talks?

Accommodation tours

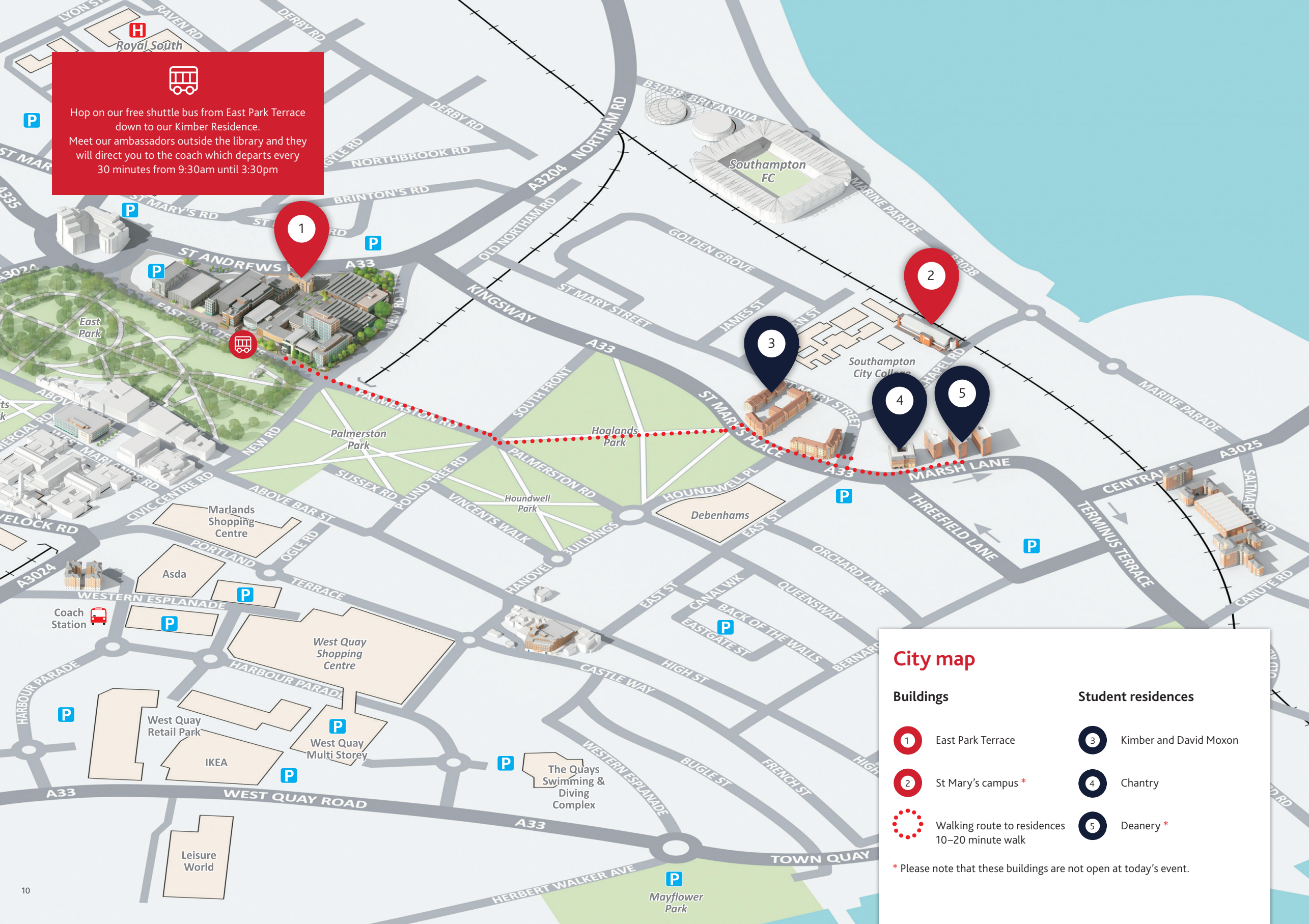

Buildings

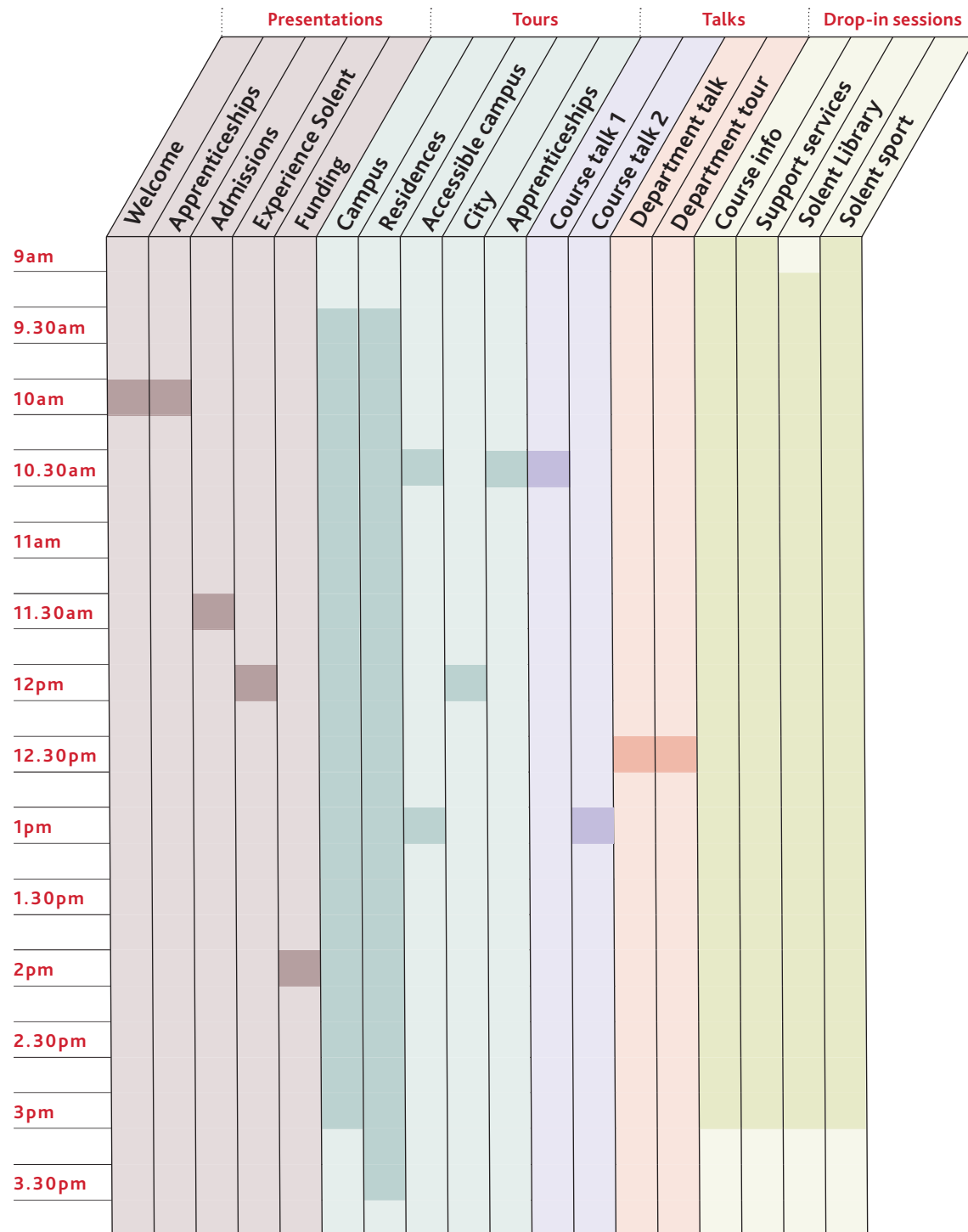
- 1 East Park Terrace
