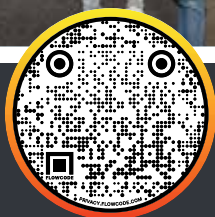

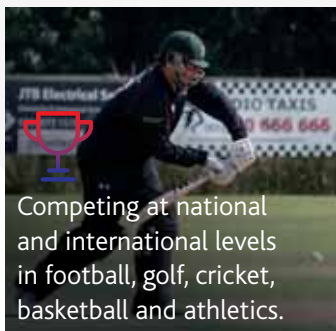

TUITION FEES AND FINANCIAL SUPPORT

As a student, you'll have two main types of expenses: tuition fees and your living costs.

EU STUDENTS

We are delighted to confirm that tuition fees for EU students will remain at the same level as UK student fees if they choose to begin their studies with us for the 2021/22 academic year. This means undergraduate student fees will remain at £9,250 per year for the duration of their study and postgraduate fees vary from £7,600 to £10,600 in line with UK student fees.

OVERSEAS (NON-EU) STUDENTS

Students living outside of the EU are known as overseas students for fee purposes.

Tuition fees vary by course, but as a guideline, for the 2021/22 academic year, undergraduate tuition fees for overseas students are £13,800 (Solent foundation year programmes are £12,000), and postgraduate tuition fees vary from £13,700 to £15,900.

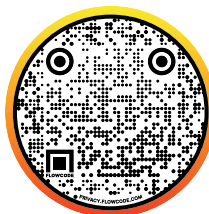
Living costs, according to the Home Office/UKVI, are estimated at approximately £1,015 per month.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Solent University is pleased to offer several scholarship schemes including:

- International Academic Merit scholarships of up to £1,000 (EU/EEA and Non-EU students)
- Vice-Chancellor scholarships of £3,000 (Non-EU students only)
- Dean's scholarships of £2,500 (Non-EU students only)
- Sport scholarships (EU/EEA and Non-EU students)
- Sanctuary scholarship: a full yearly fee waiver and a £3,000 grant to a person seeking sanctuary studying on a three-year undergraduate programme.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND HOW TO APPLY

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

To apply for an undergraduate course you must complete an online UCAS application via the UCAS website (www.ucas.ac.uk), with the appropriate fee. If you're applying through one of our official overseas representatives, please contact them directly for details on how to apply, or visit www.solent.ac.uk/solent-global

Academic entry requirements

Normal minimum entry requirements for an honours degree course are typically A-levels or equivalent high school leaving examinations.

English language requirements

To study at undergraduate level you must have achieved one of the following qualifications or other recognised equivalent:

- IELTS minimum 6.0 (with 5.5 in each component)
- CAE minimum grade C
- IB Diploma grade 5 (standard level) or grade 4 (higher level)
- Password minimum 6.0 (with 5.5 in each component)
- Duolingo 100 overall including minimum 90 in each element.

POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

Applications for our postgraduate courses are made directly to the University via our website. If you are applying through an overseas representative, they'll be able to help you complete this.

Academic entry requirements

Normal minimum entry requirements for a master's degree course are typically the equivalent of a British bachelor's degree.





English language requirements

To study at postgraduate level you must have achieved one of the following qualifications or other recognised equivalent:

- IELTS minimum dependent on course – as a guide, it will range from 6.5 to 6.0 overall (see website for further details)
- CAE minimum grade B
- CPE minimum grade C
- Password minimum dependent on course – as a guide, it will range from 6.5 to 6.0 overall (see website for further details)
- Duolingo 110 overall including minimum 90 in each element.

JANUARY AND MAY STARTS

If you are not looking to start a degree in September, some of our courses offer an opportunity to start in either January or May, allowing you to begin your studies at a time that may be more suitable for you.

TOP-UP/LEVEL 6 DEGREES AT SOLENT

If you already have a foundation degree, Higher National Diploma (HND) or equivalent qualification from your country, you may want to consider upgrading to a full undergraduate degree by studying a top-up or level 6 (year 3) bachelor's degree. It is the equivalent to studying the final year of an undergraduate degree and allows you to top up your existing qualification to a full BA, BSc or BEng (Hons) degree at Solent.

If you can't find a top-up course in your subject area, please note that some bachelor's degrees offer direct entry to level 6 (year 3). Contact the international team for further information at **international@solent.ac.uk**

VISAS AND IMMIGRATION

WHICH VISA SHOULD I APPLY FOR?

EU/EEA and Swiss nationals

Students from inside the European Economic Area (EU/EEA and Swiss nationals) are now required to either hold a Settled or Pre-Settled status or obtain a Student Visa (see below) if they wish to study in the UK on a course longer than 6 months.

Apply to the **EU Settlement Scheme** (settled and pre-settled status).

All international students

The Student Visa Route

Students from outside the UK can apply for the Entry Clearance to travel to the UK up to 6 months before their course start date. All students applying through the new Student route will need to demonstrate they meet the required 70 points. They will achieve the required points if they can demonstrate that they have an offer from Solent University (CAS), speak English and are able to support themselves financially during their studies in the UK.

Dependants

Students studying at master's level or above on a course lasting 9 months or more, or those who are Government sponsored students on a course lasting 6 months or more, are entitled to bring dependants when they apply to study in the UK. A dependant may include: spouse, an unmarried partner or a child under 18 years old. For more information, visit the **UKCISA website**.

STANDARD VISITOR VISA

If you're coming to study a short course of six months or less, you may wish to consider coming to the UK on a **Standard Visitor Visa**

VISA FEES

Visa application charges vary according to the type of visa you apply for. For more details, visit the **UK visa** web page.

In addition to the visa application fee, most students on the Student Route need to pay the Immigration Healthcare Surcharge fee. The fee buys access to the National Health Service in the UK and is linked to the duration of the visa itself. Visit the **Immigration Healthcare Surcharge fee** web page for more details.

WORKING IN THE UK

Working while studying in the UK – Solent students who come under the Student Route will be eligible to take up part-time work in the UK alongside their study.

Working after studies in the UK – Students who successfully complete a degree at undergraduate level or above in the UK, will be able to apply for a Graduate visa to stay and work or look for work for a maximum period of two years (three years for PhD students) after completing their studies. This visa route is opening in summer 2021 to international students who have completed a course at Solent University. You will also be able to move into other visa routes if you have a suitable job offer from a sponsor and can meet the requirements of a route.

Start-up visa endorsement

Solent University is an endorsing body under the Home Office's Start-up visa route. The Start-up visa is for our graduates who demonstrate high entrepreneurial potential and wish to start a business in the UK for the first time. The Start-up visa is valid for two years. After this period, you may consider switching into the Innovator Visa.

IMPROVE YOUR ENGLISH AT SOLENT

If you need to build on your existing qualifications to meet the entry requirements, the following programmes are delivered as part of a partnership between Solent University and QA Higher Education.

PRE-SESSIONAL ENGLISH

If you already meet the academic entry requirements for your chosen programme at Solent University but need additional English language support to meet the language requirements, then the Pre-Sessional English course is designed to do just that. The programme is available in different durations, depending on your current English language level and the requirement for your target programme.

By rail

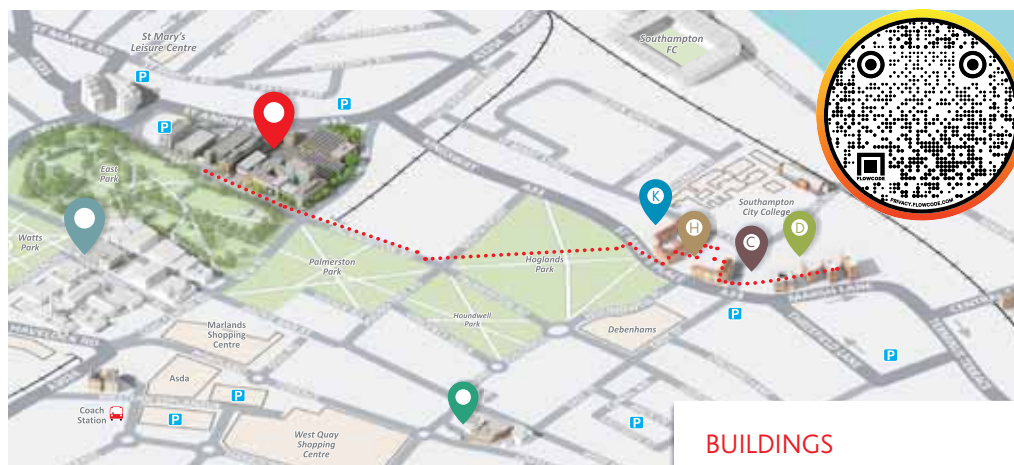
Services operate between Gatwick airport and Southampton Central. Journey time is two hours.

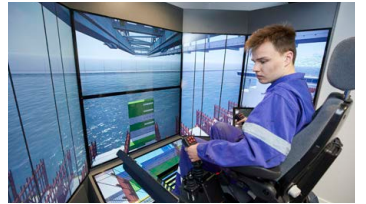
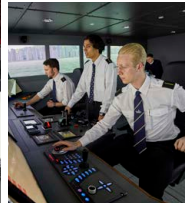
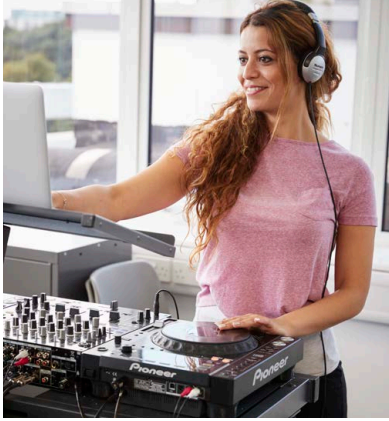
