A 60-METRE HYDRODYNAMIC TESTING TANK

Provides professional testing facilities for watercraft design. Students also have access to our temperature-controlled composite materials lab, 3D scanning and printing facilities, and a dedicated design suite.



BIOMEDICAL SCIENCE LABORATORY

Our biomedical science laboratory is purpose-built to support teaching and research in biomedical science and nutrition. The space includes two teaching laboratories, one tissue culture laboratory and one preparation and instrumentation room.



A MULTI-FUNCTION PERFORMANCE SPACE AND HD TV STUDIO

One of the biggest HD studios in the south of England. Plus two fully equipped HD TV studios, eight radio studios and ten audio recording studios; photography, animation and green-screen studios; and a professional-grade newsroom.



BESPOKE NURSING LABORATORY

Built to a bespoke design following consultation with industry, our six-bed simulated nursing ward reflects acute patient care in a clinical environment, enabling student nurses to practise their skills without any risk to patients. State-of-the-art equipment includes a high-fidelity Nursing Anne simulator – capable of verbal noises, breathing, blinking, and palpate pulses.




£1 MILLION MUSIC RECORDING STUDIOS

Recently updated, the technology in our recording studios is professional standard throughout. The primary studio features an industry-leading 24-fader, six-knob Avid S6 M40 control surface; all nine studios run on Pro Tools HD and Logic Pro X software, complemented by quality microphone pre-amps and hardware compressors, EQs and a suite of plug-ins from Sonnox, McDSP, Avid and Melodyne.



£1.3 MILLION HI-TECH SPORT SCIENCE LABORATORIES

Including purpose-built labs for biomechanics, nutrition and psychology, and a BASES-accredited physiology lab, plus all the tools you need to monitor your subjects: data collection software, motion capture, eye-tracking, reaction timers, force transducers and more.



SPECIALIST PHOTOGRAPHY STUDIO

Our campus is also home to a specialist infinity cove – a photography studio specifically designed to give the impression that the background of an object extends to infinity.

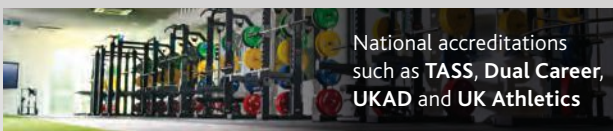

STUDENT SUPPORT

As a student at Solent you will have access to a wide range of support throughout your studies and beyond. Whether you are having financial difficulty, struggling with your mental health, need additional help with academic skills or want advice on setting up your own business, you'll find that help is always on hand.

No problem is too big or too small – and our teams are trained to offer practical support, as well as access to self-help materials and referrals to our specialist advice and support services.

THERAPY AND MENTAL HEALTH TEAM

Our therapy and mental health team offers a variety of support, including talking therapy (counselling and CBT), hypnotherapy and mental health advice.

DISABILITY SUPPORT

Access Solent provides disability support throughout your time as a student. Support includes: information and advice to prospective and current students with disabilities, advice with accessing the disabled students' allowance, screening and assessment for some conditions and short-term loans of equipment.

LEARNING SUPPORT

Access Solent also offers a range of learning support depending on needs, including: provision for individual academic-related needs, for example, exam arrangements, dyslexia tutor, mentor, note-taker, confidential advice and guidance regarding study problems, individual assistance in the library and providing assistive technology in the main IT resource centres.

STUDENT FUNDING

The student funding team provides support with all matters relating to student funding, including: student funding entitlement and application processes, assistance if funding is delayed and liaising with Student Finance England.

MONEY AND SUPPORT

As an undergraduate student, you'll have two main types of expenses – tuition fees and your living costs. Some courses also have additional or optional costs – for field visits or equipment, for example – and you can find details of these on our course pages.

TUITION FEES

For the latest information on fees, visit www.solent.ac.uk/fees

UK and EU students don't need to pay tuition fees up-front – you can apply for a loan to cover these.

Eligible students from England and the EU can apply for a loan to cover tuition fees. If you are from England, this loan doesn't depend on your household income and is paid direct to the University on your behalf. You only need to start paying this loan back when you are earning more than £25,000.

MAINTENANCE LOANS

If you are a full-time student from England, you can also apply for a loan to support you while you study, paid into your bank account in three instalments at the beginning of each academic term.

The amount available depends on:

- Where you live while studying.
- Your assessed ('means-tested') family income.
- Your entitlement to state benefits.

Other benefits are available – visit www.solent.ac.uk/dependants or contact Student Finance England.



If you are from Wales, Scotland or Northern Ireland and want to study in England, you will need to contact your own government to find out what support is available to cover tuition fees or living costs. Channel Islands and Isle of Man students are not eligible for funding from the UK government.

BURSARIES AND SCHOLARSHIPS

If your household income is under £25,000, you can also apply for various bursaries and scholarships which don't have to be repaid. Examples include the Solent University bursary, academic merit scholarships and the Lisa Wilson Scholarship.

TOP-UP DEGREES

If you've got existing skills, experience or qualifications and you'd like to make the most of them, Solent University is the ideal place to finish your undergraduate degree.

A top-up degree is essentially the final year of undergraduate study, which gives you a bachelor's level qualification. To study a top-up course, you'll need to have studied either a foundation degree or an HND in a relevant subject area.
