We are an Adobe Creative Campus, offering free student access to Adobe's suite of professional-grade creative software.

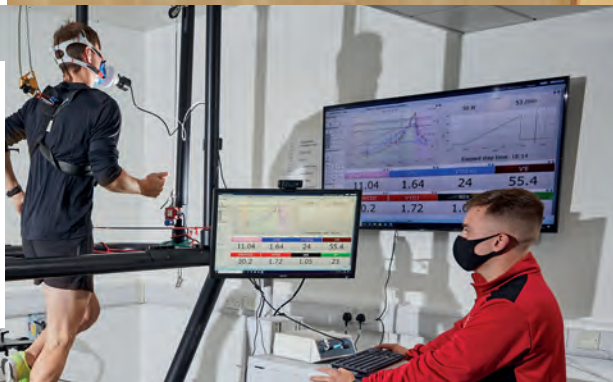
SOLENT COURTROOM

Our dedicated Solent Courtroom provides law students with state-of-the-art facilities to practise their advocacy, mooting and mock trial skills. Based on the layout of a standard courtroom – with a judge's bench, witness/defendant box, counsel benches and space for reporters – the room is equipped with multiple microphones and cameras to record advocacy and has the capacity to stream to adjoining rooms and online. It also hosts seminars and classes, as well as the Law School's Mooting and Advocacy Team practise sessions.



£1.3 MILLION HI-TECH SPORT SCIENCE LABORATORIES

Including purpose-built labs for biomechanics, nutrition and psychology, and a BASES-accredited physiology lab, plus all the tools you need to monitor your subjects: data collection software, motion capture, eye-tracking, reaction timers, force transducers and more.



BESPOKE NURSING LABORATORY

Built to a bespoke design following consultation with industry, our six-bed simulated nursing ward reflects acute patient care in a clinical environment, enabling student nurses to practise their skills without any risk to patients. State-of-the-art equipment includes a high-fidelity Nursing Anne simulator – capable of verbal noises, breathing, blinking, and palpate pulses.

One of the biggest HD studios in the South of England, featuring a camera-tracking system enabling virtual studio production. Plus two fully equipped HD TV studios, eight radio studios and ten audio recording studios; photography, animation and green-screen studios; and a professional-grade newsroom.


AN INDUSTRY-STANDARD OUTSIDE BROADCAST VEHICLE

12 recently updated industry-standard audio recording studios for multi-tracking music, recording Foley sound effects and dialogue recording for film, tv and games.



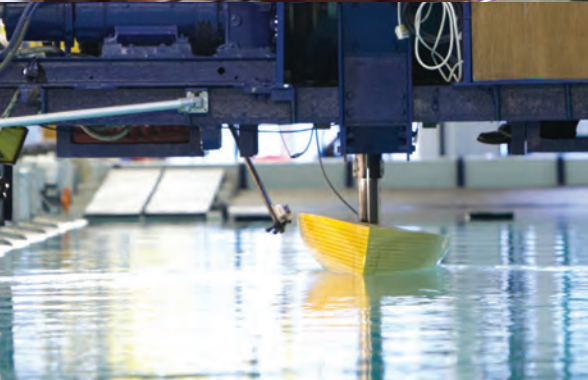
BIOMEDICAL SCIENCE LABORATORY

Our biomedical science laboratory is purpose-built to support teaching and research in biomedical science and nutrition. The space includes two teaching laboratories, one tissue culture laboratory and one preparation and instrumentation room.

Our well-stocked library is open 24 hours a day during term-time, and features a huge range of books, journals and other materials in both print and electronic format – as well as over 800 study places, including group and individual study rooms and silent study areas.

Provides professional testing facilities for watercraft design. Students also have access to our temperature-controlled composite materials lab, 3D scanning and printing facilities, and a dedicated design suite.

At Solent we are absolutely dedicated to your welfare and wellbeing: as one of our students you will have access to a wide range of support throughout your studies and beyond. Whether you are having financial difficulty, struggling with your mental health, need additional help with academic skills or want advice on setting up your own business, you'll find that help is always on hand.

No problem is ever too big or too small – and our teams are trained to offer practical support, as well as access to self-help materials and referrals to our specialist advice and support services.

THERAPY AND MENTAL HEALTH TEAM

Our therapy and mental health team offers a variety of support, including talking therapy (counselling and CBT), hypnotherapy and mental health advice.

DISABILITY AND LEARNING SUPPORT

Access Solent provides disability and learning support throughout your time as a student, including advice on accessing the disabled students' allowance, screening and assessment for some conditions, short-term loans of equipment, alternate exam arrangements, dyslexia support, confidential advice and guidance, individual assistance and assistive technology in library/IT spaces, and more.

MONEY MATTERS

As an undergraduate student, you'll have two main types of expenses – tuition fees and your living costs. Some courses also have additional or optional costs – for field visits or equipment, for example – and you can find details of these on our course pages.

TUITION FEES

For the latest information on fees, visit www.solent.ac.uk/fees

UK and EU students don't need to pay tuition fees up-front – you can apply for a loan to cover these.

Eligible students from England and the EU can apply for a loan to cover tuition fees. If you are from England, this loan doesn't depend on your household income and is paid direct to the University on your behalf. You only need to start paying this loan back when you are earning more than £25,000.

MAINTENANCE LOANS

If you are a full-time student from England, you can also apply for a loan to support you while you study, paid into your bank account in three instalments at the beginning of each academic term.

The amount available depends on:

- Where you live while studying.
- Your assessed ('means-tested') family income.
- Your entitlement to state benefits.

Other benefits are available – visit www.solent.ac.uk/dependants or contact Student Finance England.



If you are from Wales, Scotland or Northern Ireland and want to study in England, you will need to contact your own government to find out what support is available to cover tuition fees or living costs. Channel Islands and Isle of Man students are not eligible for funding from the UK government.

BURSARIES AND SCHOLARSHIPS

If your household income is under £25,000, you can also apply for various bursaries and scholarships which don't have to be repaid. Examples include the Solent University bursary, sport scholarships, academic merit scholarships and the Lisa Wilson Scholarship.

TOP-UP DEGREES

If you've got existing skills, experience or qualifications and you'd like to make the most of them, Solent University is the ideal place to finish your undergraduate degree.
