State-of-the-art facilities such as our hightech maritime simulation centre provide hands-on practical experience for students, supported by a team of dedicated technical instructors with industry experience to advise on the latest equipment and techniques.

Our world-class simulation centre, utilised by professional seafarers and industry, offers:

- State-of-the-art networked full-mission navigational bridge simulators.
- On- and off-shore crane and tug simulators.
- Electronic Chart Display and Information Systems (ECDIS) suites.
- Vessel traffic management and GMDSS radio communications.
- Full-mission engine and high voltage simulators.

We also have:

- A dedicated ship handling centre at Timsbury
- Survival craft facilities, including lifeboats, fast rescue boats, RIBs and lifting equipment.
- A purpose-built fire training facility with a two-storey steel ship/offshore unit.
- A new Bloomberg business suite, providing real-time financial information.
