Our BSc (Hons) Biomedical Science is ranked best in the country* in the subject of biomedical sciences for teaching, academic support, assessment and feedback, and learning opportunities, out of 87 institutions (NSS 2025).

- Our nursing courses achieved positivity measures of 95% for teaching, 92% for academic support, 92% for learning resources and 91% for learning opportunities (NSS 2025).
- Clinical practice offered as part of the work experience placement on some courses.
- Our social work course achieved positivity measures of 97% for learning opportunities, 94% for academic support, 93% for teaching and 92% for assessment and feedback (NSS 2025).

Throughout your studies you'll have the opportunity to use a range of high-quality facilities supported by academics with extensive industry and research experience, who will guide you to develop your skills and professional practice.

Our six-bed simulated nursing ward features a cutting-edge Anatomage table, bathroom, and kitchen facility – reflecting acute patient care in a clinical environment.

Our two teaching laboratories are comprehensively equipped and include laminar flow hoods and incubators for microbiological work, spectrophotometers for analytical biochemistry, PCR and gel electrophoresis running/imaging systems for molecular biology, and a range of microscopes for cell biology and pathology.



Students on the Health, Nutrition and Exercise Science degree get hands-on experience in our state-of-the-art sports complex. Train with clients in our teaching gyms, and explore the physiology and biomechanics labs using professional equipment to monitor and enhance human health and performance.
