## Offers of poster (for completed projects/in-development projects):

Please provide:

- A three-point summary of the poster, e.g.,
  - the purpose of the investigation,
  - o data collection approach,
  - main findings/expected findings.
- Each point should be no longer than 50 words, total submission under 150 words.
- Provide the title of the poster, the authors' names, and lead author e-mail.
- Abstracts are not required but encouraged.

## Offers of 20-minute presentation (for completed projects):

An abstract is required. The submission should consist of the following formatted as 12point font, Calibri, single line spacing and full justification. In development projects may be considered depending on the stage of completion. Please include:

- the title of the paper,
- the authors' name/s (if more than one, the author presenting the paper should be underlined),
- the e-mail address of the author giving paper
- an abstract of no more than 250 words that discusses core research question, methodology and findings, with some emphasis of original contributions
