

SOLENT IN SEPTEMBER 2020

University opening on phased return with staff returning on phased approach during July - September. (subject to Government guidance)

- Mid August after confirmation and clearing students will receive their username and password with details of how to complete online enrolment.
- Once completed Joining information will shortly be sent with access to Solent's "Get Ready" Site
- Welcome week commences WC 21/09/20
- On campus formal teaching for 1st years starting W/C 28/09/20 (further information to be provided via our website on 1st July)

Teaching will be via a mixture of online blending learning with classroom interaction

- Students will have block/ extended teaching days to reduce students on campus
- Small teaching groups, tutorials and face to face contact
- More bikes for traveling to and from campus
- Increase use of laptops
- Social distance measures (practical and laboratory, studios) etc..
- Face masks available on site
