Our programmes will support schools to make sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and school sport that will not only benefit the current pupils but also those pupils joining the school in future years.

OUT OF SCHOOL HOURS LEARNING (OSHL) CLUBS

Fun football game – used to reward the participants' learning, but to also try and make learning fun.

A report identifying areas of excellence and recommendations for improvement is provided to each school.

A baseline assessment using the real PE documents will determine current levels and highlight next steps and gaps in children's learning.

This can be carried out during PE lessons, with a PE specialist carrying out assessment with the cooperation and support of teachers and teacher assistants. Next steps and continuing assessment that can be tailored to your school's needs will be discussed with your school's representatives.

Around two in ten children aged 5-15 years meet the government's recommendations for physical activity.

This programme will ensure that your playtimes are active and enjoyable.

Your lunchtime staff will receive training that will take them through:

- how to successfully zone the space you have within your school
- · how to utilise the equipment to provide safe and engaging games
- · a repertoire of suitable games for all year groups
- · techniques to get the lunchtime training up and running.

To ensure that your lunchtime staff feel supported, this programme will also provide training for your young leaders, who will in turn make your playtimes active and enjoyable.
