# WHY CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT?

Ever wondered how that colleague manages to spin all those plates and never drop a single one? Or why students are so engaged in one unit but not another? Our aim in the Solent Learning and Teaching Institute (SLTI) is to help you answer these questions and many others by helping you in your professional development.

This shouldn't be a tick box exercise with uninspiring sessions that go in one ear and out the other. It should be a time to engage in a topic and learn how you can positively move forward in your profession. Above all, it should be useful to your practice; and that's what we offer. We understand that your time is valuable, so sessions will run for 50 minutes to allow you time to move between other commitments.

There are ways of accrediting your professional development that could help you reflect on how you could improve your practice or aim for that next promotion. We can support you through the Higher Education Academy's Fellowship application, saving you £200 in the process – check out page 7 for more.

Of course, there has to be some structure to the way you track your CPD, so we have also mapped sessions using the UK Professional Standards Framework (UKPSF) dimensions – helping you structure your CPD, understand the focus of sessions, and feed into potential HEA applications.


