Placements at Solent

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Yearlong Placements

BA Law

What is required: Placements must be in roles and within organisations approved by the faculty. These may be undertaken in more than one organisation during the placement period.

When: Academic year between years 2 and 3

BA Marketing with Advertising Management

What is required: Students are expected to work the equivalent of 46 weeks of full time (35 hours per week) employment.

When: Academic year between years 2 and 3

BA Public Relations and Communication

What is required: Students are expected to work the equivalent of 46 weeks of full time (35 hours per week) employment.

When: Academic year between years 2 and 3

BA(hons) Journalism

What is required: Students are expected to work the equivalent of 46 weeks of full time (35 hours per week) employment.

BSc Computing

What is required: For a 120 Placement credit module, Students are to work for at least 150 working days and preferably up to 45 weeks, excluding holidays and assessment preparation.

BSc Maritime Business

What is Required: Placements must be in jobs/organisations approved by the Faculty and where unavoidable may be with more than one organisation over the placement year.

MA Public Relations and Multimedia Communication

What is required: students will be expected to either secure a work placement or work-related experience such as working as a freelancer.

MSc Superyacht design

What is required: Project in a workplace, Projects should preferably have a marine industry link which can be set up between the individual and an industry contact who is working in the industry either in the UK or worldwide.

What is required: Students will be expected to secure a work placement or work-related experience, such as working as a freelancer.
